RULES & REGULATIONS**AUBURN SPRING AND AUBURN FALL ARE HELD
AT THE AUBURN AUCTION PARK IN AUBURN, INDIANA**

- Official set-up day is Wednesday 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. unless otherwise stated; however, vendors may access the park on Monday of event week.
- Swap meet vendors should enter through the northeast entrance (Gate 4) of the park.
- Car corral entrance is through the north entrance (Gate 6) on North Duesenberg Drive.
- All other vendors should enter through the northwest entrance (Gate 9) of the auction park.
- Motor coaches should enter main entrance. VIPs go to left lot, general motor homes to the right.
- Vendors located on the asphalt or in the Auction Building must be set-up and in place by 4 p.m., Wednesday and may not tear down until the last car crosses the auction block on Saturday (Spring) or Sunday (Fall) (early afternoon). Set-up hours are Monday to Tuesday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Wednesday, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.
- NO FOOD OR BEVERAGE SALES. Only contracted food vendors and concessionaires may sell food or beverage of any kind, including water.
- No selling of counterfeit products of any kind. This includes sunglasses, purses, etc.
- Vehicles used for restocking may be brought in (with a vehicle pass) between 7 a.m. and 9 a.m. All vehicles that are not part of the display/booth that are in the park after 9 a.m. will be towed unless approved and hidden in booth area.
- DUE TO ISSUES WITH POST-AUCTION CLEAN UP, ALL TRASH MUST BE CLEANED UP PRIOR TO YOUR DEPARTURE. AT AUCTION COMPANY'S DISCRETION, ANY TRASH LEFT IN A VENDOR SPACE WILL RESULT IN A \$75 FINE.
- No refunds or credits will be issued less than 19 days prior to the beginning of the event.
- All merchandise, vehicles and tent stakes must be contained within assigned space. Please note the following dimensions: Interior 10'x10', Against Building 12'x12', Pond Area 10'x10', Swap A & B 10'x30' and Car Corral 10'x20'.

- You may use the tent company of your choice. The Auction can recommend Taylor Rental 260-925-3000 or A Party Apart 260-969-0999. The Auction shall retain the right to ban any tent or structure that does not meet applicable safety standards.
- Generators are permitted as long as they do not pose a fire safety hazard, are too loud or not properly vented.
- Auctions America and Carlisle Events assume no responsibility for any damage or loss by fire, theft or any other cause whatsoever. Vendors and spectators use the facilities at their own risk and agree to indemnify and save harmless Auctions America and Carlisle Events, its agents and employees from any loss or liability including but not limited to costs of defense, arising from participation at events conducted by Auctions America and Carlisle Events and/or held at the Auburn Auction Park. Vendors will indemnify and save harmless Auctions America and Carlisle Events for any such loss or liability arising from conduct of any vendor towards another vendor or the public.
- Auctions America and Carlisle Events reserve the right to reject application for space rental or renewal on the basis of unsatisfactory previous conduct, merchandise that does not fit within the scope of the event, or upon any other basis made in the sole determination and at the sole discretion of Auctions America and Carlisle Events. Auctions America and Carlisle Events also reserve the right to remove individuals who exhibit unsatisfactory behavior during an event.
- Misuse of any show credentials may result in ejection from Auction Park.
- Failure to comply with any of the rules and regulations may result in loss of the willingness of Auctions America and Carlisle Events to renew a space rental in the future.
